



Coromandel Valley Kindergarten

PRIORITY OF ACCESS POLICY

Level 1 – children will be able to attend as a priority one if they meet the following criteria:

(placement offer in August)

- Special Rights
- Guardian Of The Minister
- Aboriginal and Torres Straight Islanders
- Their residential address is within the designated zone area

Level 2 – children will be able to attend as a priority two if they meet the following criteria:

(placement offer in September)

- Had a sibling attend Coromandel Valley Kindergarten
- Will be attending Coromandel Valley Primary school
- Will be attending Craighburn Primary school
- Their residential address is outside of the designated zone area

All families who enrol in the Kindergarten will be sent an invitation to attend an information session.

Families who are level one will be placed on the enrolment register and families informed.

Families who are level two will be offered a place for the yearly intake and respondents details placed on the enrolment register.

All families will be responsible for making a decision and following up with their response to accept or decline a placement offer in a timely manner to secure a place for their child in the yearly intake. A cut-off date will be communicated to families as part of the offer of placement.
